This letter is to inform you of the decision by the Board of Directors of the Professional Surveyors Association of Nebraska (PSAN) regarding the Professional Development Hours (PDHs) related to the 2019 Summer Seminar held in Norfolk, NE.

It is the Board's understanding that the BLM presenters that were scheduled for the afternoon session of the seminar were sick and unable to fill the time for session. It is also understood that the presenters offered to provide a webinar to be viewed at the attendee's leisure. While it is appreciated that they offered the option it is hard to track who watched the webinar since there was no certificate offered by the BLM to authenticate attendance.

At the September meeting of the PSAN Board of Director's it was decided that the Board could not ethically issue full PDH credit to the attendees of the 2019 Summer Seminar since the time was not all filled and that the attendees of the 2019 Summer Seminar would receive credit for four (4) hours of Professional Development and that a \$40.00 credit redeemable at the 2020 Winter Seminar in Kearney, NE, would be the best solution.
