At today's quarterly PSAN Board meeting, the Board made several important decisions on behalf of our association. As the COVID-19 pandemic continues an upward trend throughout Nebraska, we felt that it was not in our best interest to have an in-person Winter Conference as originally scheduled for February 11 & 12, 2021. Below are the details of these decisions:

The 2021 Winter Conference is being postponed to July 22 & 23, 2021 at the Kearney Holiday Inn.
We plan to have this conference in-person.

The Annual Meeting will be held virtually on February 12, 2021 at 9AM MT / 10AM CT. The specific details will be communicated prior to this meeting. Our bylaws dictate that this meeting be conducted during the first quarter of the year.

The PSAN Board approved a final draft of the Minimum Standards today. The committee and board have been extremely transparent and forthright with this process and have provided our members the opportunity to provide their input formally on two different drafts. A vote to approve or disapprove the revised Minimum Standards will be conducted via mail-in ballot at the same time as the PSAN election of officers ballot. After evaluating several options, we feel this is the best way to collect these votes.

We will announce the results of the election of officers and the Minimum Standards at the virtual Annual Meeting.

The 2022 Summer Seminar will be held in Nebraska City, hosted by David Schmitz and Tom Catlett. We are still looking for a 2022 Winter Seminar host (to be held in Kearney).

The year 2020 has been challenging and strange, to say the least. Our ability to adapt and overcome will continue to be tested until this pandemic is in check. I want you to know that our Board is working hard to make the best decisions for our members and for the people of the great state of Nebraska.
